Afternoon Departure 4:30 pm

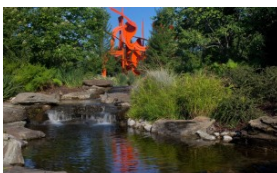


Chrysanthemums and More!

Highlights thousands of flowering chrysanthemums in both interior and exterior venues. Vertical columns of colorful chrysanthemums, a vibrant wall of chrysanthemums, chrysanthemum spheres and beds of colorful plants delight visitors.

This is the largest display of its kind in Michigan.

Sculpture Collection



The Sculpture Park features significant works of art within a variety of natural settings connected by waterways, meandering paths, lawns, meadows and quiet walkways.

Within the Sculpture Park's 30 acres is one of the most comprehensive collections of outdoor sculpture in the world. Wear comfy shoes and bring a camera.

The Richard & Helen DeVos Japanese Garden

Enjoy the tranquility, simplicity and beauty that are the very essence of the Japanese Garden which opened in 2015. One of the most revered and deeply appreciated international garden styles, this 8-acre addition furthers the organization's dual mission of horticulture and sculpture.

Frederik Meijer Gardens and Sculpture Park

Frederik Meijer Gardens & Sculpture Park integrates the experience of striking gardens with fine art. The emphasis is on horticultural displays showcasing a beautiful array of plants appropriate for the Midwest and specialized plants from regions around the world. Permanent attractions include the Lena Meijer Tropical Conservatory, the Leslie E Tassell English Perennial and Bulb Garden, the Gwen Frostic Woodland Shade Garden, the Kenneth E Nelsen Carnivorous Plant House, the Earl and Donnalee Holton Arid Garden, the Earl and Donnalee Holton Victorian Garden Parlor and Michigan's Farm Garden.

Ranked in the top 100 most-visited art museums worldwide by *Art Newspaper*, the Frederik Meijer Gardens & Sculpture Park has grown to become an international destination. The Sculpture program includes more than 200 works both indoors and outdoors on the 158-acre main campus. The permanent collection includes works by Carrier-Belluèse, Degas and Rodin.

The DeVos Keeler Gift Shop offers original and locally made gift selections. A wide variety of house plants, handmade pots and line of gardening books are available for purchase.

The Taste of Gardens Café is available for lunch with its dazzling glass ceiling sculpture by artist Dale Chihuly. There are sandwiches, wraps, salads, soup, deli sides and desserts offered.

A picnic area is available adjacent to the parking lot. No food or beverages are allowed to be brought into the Gardens.
