- Certified

 - Can use CE as service hours if needed

Blanket Exemptions

- Project exemption #435
 - June 30, 2021
- Not a blanket exemption – submit by county. Planning and Preparation Meeting exemption #048
 - June 30, 2021
- All others must be submitted on your own
 - Plant sales, will be permitted (for now)
 - Garden tours, classes, etc. for now

Blanket exemptions for meetings

- Educator must submit – under 50 people
 - Template in box for meetings
 - MGV Shared Resources/Covid 19 exemption/MGVface2face meetings
 - Follow approval email for details
 - Must have 30 sq.ft. per person
 - Health reporting
 - Tracking attendees
 - Purchases tied to exemption

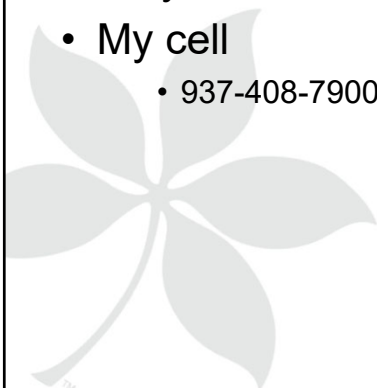
